

“V8 EXPERIENCE THE STAR SYDNEY - ENTER TO WIN” PROMOTION

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter and the prize form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. The promoter is Premium Beverages Pty Ltd (ABN 71 100 818 700) of Unit 2, 11 Sabre Drive, Port Melbourne VIC 3207, telephone 1300 555 166 (“**Promoter**”).
3. Entry is only open to Australian residents aged 18 years or over who are able to travel to the Gold Coast, QLD between 19/10/2018 and 21/10/2018 if drawn as a winner.
4. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, The Star Sydney and agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
5. The promotion will be conducted in The Star Sydney, 80 Pyrmont Street, Pyrmont NSW 2009 (“**Participating Venue**”), commencing on 17/07/2018 and ending at 11:59pm AEST on 31/08/2018 (“**Promotional Period**”).
6. To be eligible to enter individuals must, during the Promotional Period, purchase any Coopers drink from the Participating Venue during the Promotional Period (“**Qualifying Transaction**”). Individuals will receive an official entry form at point of making a Qualifying Transaction while stocks of entry forms last. It is the responsibility of the entrants to ensure that they receive an entry form if one is not automatically provided to them.
7. To enter, individuals must then complete the official entry form in full and place it in the entry box provided at the Participating Venue during the Promotional Period.
8. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant’s identity, age and place of residence) and reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these Terms and Conditions, tampered with the entry process or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise fair and proper conduct of the promotion. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter’s discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights. The Promoter’s legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.

Multiple entries permitted, subject to the following: (a) only one (1) entry is permitted per Qualifying Transaction regardless of the number of drinks purchased in that transaction; (b) a maximum of one (1) entry is permitted per person per day; and (c) each entry must be submitted separately and in accordance with entry requirements.
10. If there is a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the entrant.
11. The draw will take place at the Participating Venue on 04/09/2018 at 4:00pm AEST. A staff member, on behalf of the Promoter may draw additional reserve entries and record them in order in case an invalid entry or ineligible entrant is drawn. The winner will be notified in writing within two (2) business days of the draw. The winner’s name will be announced online at www.coopers.com.au from 06/09/2018.
12. The Promoter’s decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
13. The first valid entry drawn will a trip for two (2) adults to the Gold Coast, QLD for the Gold Coast 600 Supercars valued at up to \$2,040. Prize includes:

- Two (2) return economy flights from Sydney, NSW to Gold Coast QLD;
 - Two (2) nights twin share accommodation at The Star, Gold Coast including dinner for two (a) adults on one (1) night up to the value of \$722;
 - Return airport to hotel transfers; and
 - Two (2) corporate tickets to the Gold Coast 600 Supercars event on either Saturday 20/10/2018 or Sunday 21/10/2018 (as determined by the Promoter in its absolute discretion) including a hot lap for the winner and a pre-race grid walk.

The Promoter and event organisers hereby expressly reserve the right to eject the winner (and/or his/her companion/s) for any inappropriate behaviour, including but not limited to intoxication, whilst participating in any element of the prize. The winner and his/her companion/s may be required to sign a waiver prior to being allowed to race on the track.
 17. The Promoter encourages consumers to enjoy responsibly. Entry and continued participation in this promotion is subject to the licensee's liquor serving policy.
 18. Subject to the unclaimed prize draw clause, if for any reason the winner does not redeem the prize by the time stipulated by the Promoter, then the prize will be forfeited.

Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the promotion.

Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) is not responsible for and exclude all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of: (a) any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Promoter's control); (b) any theft, unauthorised access or third party interference; (c) any entry or prize claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; (d) any variation in prize value to that stated in these Terms and Conditions; (e) if the Gold Coast 600 event is delayed, postponed or cancelled for any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; (f) any tax liability incurred by a winner or entrant; or (g) use of the prize.
